The Vineyard Southgate Recreation and Park District Park Improvement Development Impact Fee was established to finance basic park improvements, a portion of a community center, tot lots and recreational fields and miscellaneous structures in the Vineyard Financing Plan area (excluding the Vineyard Springs area). This fee program was previously known as the Elk Grove/West Vineyard Development Fee Program. Facilities are detailed in the Vineyard Public Facilities Financing Plan Development Impact Fee Program Nexus Study approved by the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors on February 7, 2006.
